OPEN 2021 GRANT CYCLE

Paralyzed Veterans of America Spinal Cord Injury Research Foundation funds grants to promote innovative research to find treatments and cures for paralysis, and support efforts to improve lives of individuals living with SCI/D until treatments are found. In addition, the Foundation funds SCI Fellowships to encourage young researchers to specialize in the area of spinal cord research.

Awards will be made in November 2020 for the funding period **January 1, 2021 – December 30, 2022.**

Research Grants: Up to \$150,000 (two years)

Fellowship Grants: Up to \$100,000 (two years)

- Clinical Applications
- Post-Doctoral Fellowships

Grant application period opens **April 1, 2020.**
